Teaching format / class hours per week during the semester:	<p>a. Lectures : Project Based Learning with methods such as Presentations, Group and Class Discussion method. (3 x 50 minutes = 150 minutes)</p> <p>b. Structured assignment : Weekly individual written assignment. (3 x 60 minutes = 180 minutes).</p> <p>c. Individual study (3 x 60 minutes = 180 minutes)</p>
Workload:	Total workload is 136 hours per semester which consists of 150 minutes lectures, 180 minutes structured activities, and 180 minutes self-study per week for 16 weeks.

Course Outcomes:	<p>After completing this course, the students have ability to:</p> <p>CO 1. Analyze the nature of humans, the nature of religion, the sources of Islamic teachings, the main teachings in Islam, and Islamic insights</p> <p>CO 2. Identify sources of Islamic teachings and main Islamic teachings.</p> <p>CO 3. Resolve religious problems in the main studies of Islam and Islamic insight.</p>
Content:	This lecture discusses the nature of humans, the nature of religion, Al-quran as the main source of Islamic teachings, sunnah and hadith, ijtilhad, faith, sharia, morals, Islamic family development, Islamic economics, politics, Islamic knowledge, issues of the Islamic community, and Islamic student ethics
Study/exam achievements:	<p>The final grade will be weighted as follows:</p> <p>The assessment consists of a final exam (35%), a midterm exam (30%), assignment: paper presentation and case studies (25 %), and class activities/affective score (10%).</p> <p>The final and midterm exams are essay tests with a closed book (120 minutes).</p> <p>Paper Presentations: Students will be divided into several small groups. Each of the groups will assign a particular topic related to the learning content. They should discuss the topic, prepare the paper and conduct a class presentation.</p> <p>Case studies: Students are required to choose a topic related to the learning content. At the end of the semester, they write a paper about a case related to the topic and find a solution for the case based on their opinion.</p>
